


Human Immunodeficiency Virus in Adults Testing

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OFFER ONE TIME SCREENING TO ALL ADULTS AND CHILDREN >13 YEARS AND MORE FREQUENT SCREENING FOR HIGH-RISK^{*} PATIENTS



Notes

* Previous blood product recipient, intravenous drug abuse, multiple sexual encounters, chronic hepatitis, organ donors, recurrent pneumonia, and/or tuberculosis

** Consider retesting in high-risk patients if clinically indicated

*** If the initial screen performed was an Ag/Ab combination assay, NAAT testing is recommended for follow-up; NAAT testing is also recommended following a negative Western blot if recent exposure or primary/ acute HIV infection is suspected
